The titles of the supervisors on letterheads, business cards, internet or in books are not relevant. The relevant document is the one that authorizes the use of the academic degree.

- Declaration concerning the doctoral thesis (must be submitted in the original with the hand-written signature!)
- Curriculum vitae
- Proof of payment of the doctoral fee

 (1:00 pm) before the meeting of the doctoral admissions board committee. We require:
 - an electronic version by email
 - an electronic version on USB stick
 - a version for each reviewer (hardback printout, no spiral binding) and an additional version for the Departmental Office.
- If the doctoral thesis is written in English, a summary in German must be provided.
